

# "The New Global Awareness"

## Article 3: The New Global Awareness and "Politics"

Welcome to the third and final article in this short series of weekly Tuesday articles explaining what "The New Global Awareness" is.

In addition, by changing our awareness of the reality we live in, to the level we are talking about here, we will also be changing the way we actually perceive our reality and the way we perceive one another. And with that change in perception also comes the awareness of how we are all connected as one, giving us that neutral "common ground" needed for our global community to unite.

### ***Politics***

A good way to communicate what is said in the book about our "political and economical systems" is to look at some of the section headings (*see below*) grouped under the main heading entitled "*Moving forward*", which basically is all about "Politics":

- *Civilization and Politics*
- *An Unsustainable System*
- *A Concept Model for a Future Global Civilization*
- *Building a New System*
- *Competitiveness*
- *New Price Structures*
- *Employment in the Future*
- *Time to Play*

- *An End to All Wars*

While many of these section headings essentially speak for themselves in regards to what is being discussed, what the number of headings also shows us is that the subject of "Politics" is one which the book covers at great length.

In light of the recent Presidential Election in the USA and the controversies surrounding it and in light of the growing concern amongst the general public world wide, that our worldly system is going downhill real fast - there is no question that both politics and the topic of "democracy" are going to be some of the hottest topics for discussion in the coming months and years.

As our world is rapidly becoming one global community, what we need to come to terms with is that what one country does, no longer can be considered the sole business of that country. Dividing our globe into small sovereign countries and states worked well in the past when the world was perceived as an almost endlessly big place. But this is no longer the case.

When a minority in our global community, such as for example the citizens of the USA, these days elect a new President for their country, a country which also happens to have a major influence and impact on everyone else's lives in our global community - we as a global community are only right in questioning the fairness of this. Should not all of us in the global community have a say in elections which affects *all of us* - worldwide - and which will have a major impact on our personal lives too? (Just think about issues such as trade, buying power, economics and global stability etc).

Perhaps the time has come for us to rethink the structure of our global system; to finally put to rest our current primitive structure of a world lead by a handful of super egos. As mentioned in the book "The New Global Awareness":

*"...We as a global society need to set a new direction in which to move forward - one with an emphasis on our oneness; an emphasis on enhancing our shared life experience".*



The fact is that the way our current global system works is simply unsustainable. Our current politicians with their narrow-minded thinking seem to only see "growth" as a means to improve our quality of life. But the truth is that their focus of never-ending growth and the inherent indirect encouragement of greed and self-centeredness that follows only makes things worse for us all.

A system that is focused and built on a constant pursuit of ever-increasing growth, automation, labor cutbacks and overuse of resources is simply unsustainable.

Cutbacks everywhere are creating more and more unemployment; home-mortgages are becoming unaffordable for more and more people; homelessness is on the increase; more and more people are forced to work longer hours, or to have multiple jobs, just to keep up with paying the bills etc.

What we are looking at, is a system which is out of control. A system where the cutbacks, automation and the relentless pursuit of increased profit margins and growth is causing more and more suffering and despair for more and more people, while those who already have the wealth just keep accumulating more and more wealth as an inherent malfunction of the system.

As mentioned in the book about how this narrow-minded thinking affects more and more of us in our global community:

*"...what we as a global society see and experience is how prices on basically everything just keep rising, to the point of suffocating us, as those who possess the wealth just keep passing on the cost of their increasing wealth and profit margins to us, for us to pay for.*

*No wonder then that so many people in our global society feel discontent and unhappy. The fact is that these things are totally outside of the control of most ordinary people. The majority of people do not have so much money that they do not know what to do with it. They do not have any surplus to invest anywhere (a simple search on the internet for poverty statistics shows that far more than half of the worlds' population is living in poverty). They have no input in deciding about prices; costs; cutbacks or charges.*

*While businesses, banks and governments are able to hand down their increased costs to their customers, ordinary people do not have the luxury of being able to pass on their increased costs to anyone, they are the ones left to pay the bills. They have no practical say in the matter, but they have to live with the consequences of decisions and actions carried out by a handful of powerful people."*

That being said, what we need to realize is that it is not really the people, but the system that is the problem. Certainly, to have a world lead by a handful of narrow-minded super egos does not help, but at the core of the problem lies an out of control system that puts profit before humanity.

To overcome the many issues we have in our current global system, the book first looks at the unsustainable nature of our system, both political and economical, and what drives it. It then looks at an alternative future system with the capacity to overcome

these many issues. A drastically different new type of system based on true democracy, accountability and transparency.

To give you an idea of what this new system entails; a system which puts humanity and a better life experience for all as a priority, I have included a few snippets here from the book "The New Global Awareness":

*"... But not only should we never allow a single person to govern or control us all, nor should we ever give the power to govern us all to a governing body elected for a set period of time in which they basically can do as they please i.e. effectively making it a four year dictatorship. This type of governing structure is far too open to abuse of power, as often seen in today's governments..."*

*"... Actually, for us to create a fairer system for us all we need our governments to plug into our oneness; we all need to work together as a oneness. We need to abandon elections set at periodic intervals, which basically allows our politicians to disconnect from society while being in government. We need to abandon a system where democratically elected governments mainly look after the interest of a handful of powerful friends and individuals once they are in power. We need to put an end to a system that allows self-serving profit-focused lobbying groups, who on behalf of large organizations (often multinational organizations), influence not only government decisions, but also industry-specific associations, research institutions and advisory groups which both the government and the public rely on for advice, regarding issues relating to health and so on. Besides, these practices also undermine the whole purpose of elections and make a mockery of our democracy..."*

*"...no-one trusted with the responsibility of being part of the government should ever be able to take their position for granted..."*

*"...In other words, there would be no permanency about a position. The individual would be replaceable at any time, should they for example repeatedly fail in their tasks; be found to be dishonest; or if someone more suitable for the task is available to take over. But that being said, it could also be a question of adding someone extra rather than replacing someone. The focus should always be on whatever serves us and the circumstances best.*

*Ideally, rather than viewing it as a typical workplace where people have a feeling of ownership of their position, it ought to have a more relaxed atmosphere; a fluid environment without any strict guidelines for the number of members that the "new system" could have. For we need to remember that the objective of having the "new system" would be to serve what is in the best interests of our society. That means that as the issues in need of attention would change over time, so too would the number of members and the composition of members best qualified and most suitable to deal with the issues at hand, also change over time to reflect those needs..."*

The details of how this alternative system is designed and organized can naturally be found in the book. But in short what we are talking about here is a system which promotes and encourages global harmony. It represents a whole new level of civilization in which we *all* can unfold and achieve an optimized life experience, one that widens

"the good life experience" to include all of us. It is a system that reprioritizes what is important to us and puts humanity above profits, self-centeredness and greed.

To illustrate what this alternative future system is intended to deal with, it can be mentioned that it provides solutions to all of the following problems and issues (and many more):

- General unrest and disconnectedness in our society
- Healthcare
- Poverty
- Living conditions
- Inequality and the growing gap between the "haves" and the "have-nots"
- Unemployment due to Industrial automation and relocation of manufacturing
- Failing political and economical systems
- Greed and self-centeredness
- Financial crises
- Overuse of global resources
- Terrorism
- Religious fanaticism
- Dictatorships
- War
- Refugee issues
- Drug abuse
- Human trafficking
- Slavery
- Exploitation

Imagine a world free from all these negatives. Imagine a world in which humanity comes first. One in which human rights, food, water, housing, education, health and healthcare are all taken care of - a world where each and every individual has a sense of belonging and purpose. Through this awareness (i.e. "The New Global Awareness") we are about to make that change - to create that positive, uplifting and energizing life experience we are all dreaming of with a new and elevated feeling of excitement.
